YOUTH HELPER



Youth helpers are teens between Grade 7 and Grade 12 who are following Jesus, who regularly attend St. John's, and who want to grow in their faith by serving as part of a teaching team alongside experienced staff and lay leaders.

Key Responsibilities

- 1. Support your teaching team by encouraging the kids in your group, helping them stay focussed, connecting with them personally, and assisting them with activities.
- 2. Lead one component of the lesson if you are comfortable and have discussed it with your teaching team (this can change as you grow in your role throughout the year).

Time Commitment

- Morning Service: serve approximately twice a month
- Evening Service: serve once per month
- Read through the posted lessons during the week
- Attend two training evenings per year
